

Kura Raumati Māori & Fatu Malosi Pasifika Student Research Programmes



University & Community Supervisor Information

The Putahi Manawa Kura Raumati and Fatu Malosi student research programmes aim to provide opportunities for tauira Māori and Pasifika students studying at a tertiary level to participate in a heart health equity programme of research over the summer holidays. Students will have an interest in developing their skills, knowledge, and networks, and in contributing to the wider kaupapa | work of supporting our whānau, hapū, iwi, and Pasifika communities on their heart health journey.

Programme overview

Students will start the ten-week programme engaged in a week-long wānanga on marae or fonotaga exploring kaupapa Māori and Pasifika heart health approaches, respectively. They then spend time undertaking their research projects which concludes with tauira coming together and presenting their findings, experiences, and insights to each other, to their supervisors and to their communities.

The programmes run from the week of 17 November to 13th February, with a three-week break over the Christmas and New Year period.

Payments

Pūtahi Manawa Kura Raumati and Fatu Malosi students will receive either a tax-free stipend of \$8,000 or a taxable stipend of \$9,000.


Students will preferentially receive the tax-free stipend of \$8,000, provided the host institution is willing and able to administer it. In this case, the institution will manage the payment process, including the timing and frequency of payments. Please note that this varies by institution, and Pūtahi Manawa does not have control over the timing of payments made by institutions. Delays may occur that are outside Pūtahi Manawa's control.

If a tax-free stipend cannot be administered by the host institution, Pūtahi Manawa will arrange a taxable stipend of \$9,000, paid directly to the student through a contract with the University of Auckland. This will be paid in three instalments. If payment cannot be made via a contract, a casual contract will be administered instead, with tax already deducted from the stipend. Those on casual contracts will be paid fortnightly. Delays related to contracting processes may occur and are outside of Pūtahi Manawa's control.

Tax

If students are paid via contract, they will be responsible for meeting their own tax obligations (e.g., filing a tax return or paying tax owed). We will provide further guidance during the onboarding process for students. Tax on casual contracts may be deducted at a higher rate resulting in a tax overpayment which would need to be reclaimed from the IRD by completing a tax return.
